

**Youth Coordinator for Unity of East Louisville**  
**Part-time up to 10 hours a week, including Sundays.'**  
**Stipend \$100 week**

**Purpose:** The Youth Coordinator is a paid position for the Unity of East Louisville Community to foster the development, engagement, and empowerment of our youth. The person will play a critical role in fostering a supportive, inclusive environment that nurtures personal growth, community involvement, and leadership skills among young people.

**Objectives:**

1. **Engage Youth Partners:** Assist with preparing curriculum and implementing activities that actively engage youth partners to grow spiritually grounded in Unity Principles and the community.
1. **Foster Personal Growth:** Provide opportunities for youth to develop spiritual skills, build self-confidence, and explore their interests.
2. **Encourage Community Involvement:** Promote youth participation in community events, sacred service opportunities, and decision-making processes.
3. **Develop Leadership Skills:** Assist in creating leadership development programs to empower youth to take on leadership roles within the community.

**Roles and Responsibilities:**

- Assist with planning, organizing, and overseeing youth programs and activities.
- Assist with recruiting, training, and supporting roles in sacred service to support youth programs.
- Establish and maintain positive relationships with youth, parents, and community partners.
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of youth programs and make improvements as needed.
- Collaborate with other community organizations and partners to enhance program offerings.
- Ensure the teens have support for fundraising and attending regional or international events

**Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's degree in Education, Social Work, Youth Development, or a related field or equivalent work experience.
- Minimum of 3 years of experience working with youth in a community or educational setting.
- Strong organizational and leadership skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal abilities.
- Ability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends.
